




REMINDING ALL PARENTS AND CARERS

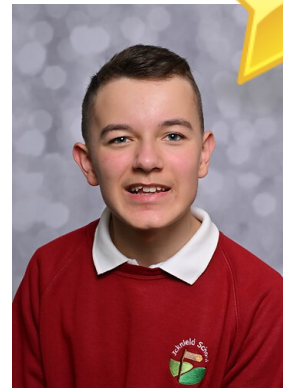
